GUIDELINES FOR INCLEMENT WEATHER

PLAYING MATCHES AS SCHEDULED IS THE #1 PRIORITY

- 1) If the course is OPEN, the matches **must** be played as originally scheduled. If the course is CLOSED (as determined **solely** by the host club's superintendent), the matches must be rescheduled. The Series Captain, in conjunction with the host club, determines the reschedule date. If there is no date available at the host club prior to the Challenge Matches, a neutral site/date must be obtained by the Series Captain.
- 2) If there is a DELAY, the team must be ready to play, with the intent of completing the round, when the course is deemed open by the host club. Otherwise, the team will be penalized in accordance with the "Rules for Team Matches - Delay or Cancellation of Play" in the TSB.
- 3) If the course is OPEN, **closed to carts** and there are enough caddies for all players, the matches **must** be played as originally scheduled. If a player cannot walk/chooses not to walk when caddies are available, she forfeits her points. However, her team does not move its players up.
- 4) If the course is OPEN, **closed to carts** and there aren't enough caddies for all players, but there are enough caddies for either the first two or the first two teams, those matches will be played as in #3 above. The remaining matches will be rescheduled.
- 5) The determination of eligibility of who can play in any rescheduled matches is laid out in the TSB
